

2018 PRE-BUDGET CONSULTATIONS WITH THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

Chicken Farmers of Canada made a submission to the Standing Committee on Finance's 2018 pre-budget consultations with a goal of appearing before the Committee this fall.

This would be an opportunity to discuss the issues facing our sector, that if fixed, will create more jobs for Canadians, and further stimulate economic growth – goals that are aligned with the federal government's mandate. Our recommendations are reasonable, practical, and trade-compliant, and will strengthen our sector.

Our recommendations to stop illegal imports of chicken labelled as spent fowl, to exclude chicken from the Duties Relief Program and to reinstate the sauce and cooking requirements into the Customs Tariff will create 4,456 new jobs, contribute an additional \$335 million to Canada's GDP and generate \$112 million in additional taxes.

The Canadian chicken sector continues to grow in part thanks to the support for both our sector and supply management that continues to be demonstrated by all parties in the House of Commons. We look forward to that support continuing throughout the rest of the mandate, including the annual budget planning process.
