- One program, one set of requirements for all Canadian chicken farmers
- CFC is responsible for development and oversight and provincial boards are responsible for the auditing and certification services
- Both programs use an ISO-based management system

- Animal Care: Broad stakeholder input and full recognition through the National Farm Animal Care Council's Animal Care Assessment Framework
- Food Safety: Full federal, provincial, and territorial government recognition through the Canadian Food Inspection Agency's Food Safety Recognition Program

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
