Year-to-date (YTD) fresh supply reached 952.8 Mkg for August 2018, an increase of 4.7% (43.1 Mkg) over last year. Supply levels continued their growth from production, which sat at 841.8 Mkg, up 5.9% (46.6 Mkg) from last year.





#### Total Chicken Imports (Mkg)



YTD chicken imports for August 2018 were down 3.0% (3.4 Mkg) over last year. Looking at each category, the largest volume decline came from Parts Bone-in, which fell 6.6 Mkg (21.4%), followed by the Other category, which fell 2.7 Mkg (69.2%). While it only represents a volume decline of 0.6 Mkg, the Carcass category had the largest percentage drop over last year. Conversely, some positive growth was experienced in the Parts Boneless, which grew 9.1% (5.3 Mkg), along with Further Processed, which increased 5.7% (1.2 Mkg).





The consumer price index (CPI) for chicken as of August 2018 was 154.2, a decrease of 1.5 points (1%) over last year. In the same time frame, beef dropped from 181.5 to 179.1, and pork fell from 143.2 to 143.0. Regardless of the meat, the declining price indexes are opposite to the increasing index for Food, which was 144.2 last year, and was 145.1 in August 2018.

The market composite for September 2018 was \$3.61/kg, a drop of \$0.41 over last year. Every complex has seen a decline over last year, though the most significant has been in the wing complex, which fell \$1.05, from \$5.68/kg to \$4.63/kg. Another noteworthy drop was experienced in the breast complex, which fell \$0.68, from \$6.35/kg to \$5.67/kg. Meanwhile, drops of \$0.12 were seen in the whole bird complex, and \$0.58 in the leg complex.





#### Total Chicken Storage Stocks ('000 Kg)



Storage stocks level fell for the second month in a row in September 2018, where total stock levels amounted to 47.8 Mkg. The declines in stock levels came from Ontario and Quebec, which respectively experienced drops of 0.2 Mkg and 1.3 Mkg over August 2018. At a category level, the largest decline came from the Miscellaneous category which fell 0.7 Mkg over last month. In addition, the Further Processed category fell 0.3 Mkg, and Cut-Up fell 0.2 Mkg.




#### USDA - Wholesale prices


Weighted Average - Cents per pound




U.S. wholesale prices for September 2018 were down in every cut except for wings, which saw a \$0.04 increase on average from last month-- \$0.07 in the North-East, and \$0.01 in the Southern U.S. A notable drop of \$0.12 was seen in B/S Breasts, bringing the average price to \$0.99/lb. Most of the decline in B/S Breasts came from the North-East, which dropped 0.17, compared to the South which only experienced a \$0.07 decline. Meanwhile, small drops of \$0.03 were seen in B/S Thighs, and \$0.01 in Drumsticks.
