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Fresh supply volumes as of February 2019 year-to-date (YTD) reached 230.9 Mkg, increasing 5.0 Mkg (\pm 2.2%) over the same timeframe last year. A good portion of the increase can be attributed to production, which increased by 7.1 Mkg (\pm 3.5%), while YTD imports were down 2.1 Mkg (\pm 8.9%).

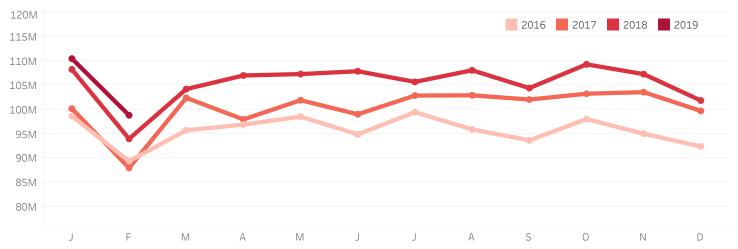

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Canadian Chicken Production (Mkg) Production de poulet au Canada (Mkg)



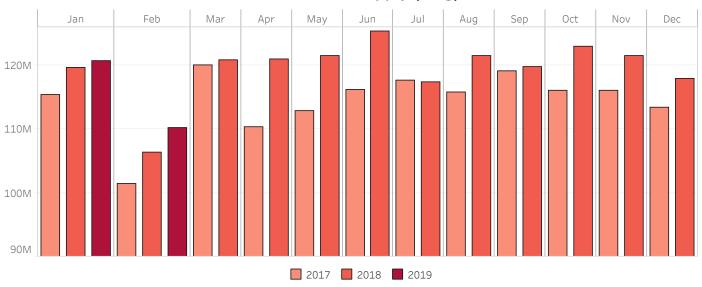

YTD production reached 209.3 Mkg, increasing 7.1 Mkg (+3.5%) over last year. On a percentage basis, the strongest year-over-year (YOY) increases were in New Brunswick (+9.9%), Quebec (+6.2%), Alberta (+5.1%), and Manitoba (+4.9%). On a volume basis, Quebec experienced the largest YOY increase of +3.3 Mkg, followed by Ontario (+1.5 Mkg), and Alberta (+1.0 Mkg).

Domestic Disappearance for February 2019 stood at 205.0 Mkg, up 7.3 Mkg (+3.7%) over 2018.

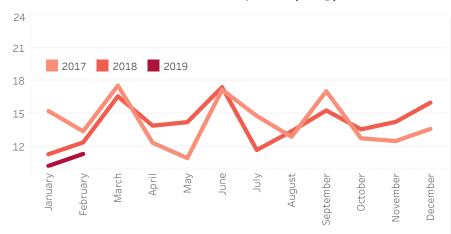

Chicken imports for February 2019 YTD were down 2.1 Mkg (-8.9%). Most of the decline came from bone-in parts, which dropped 1.3 Mkg (-26.7%), followed by boneless parts, which fell 1.1 Mkg (-8.3%). Meanwhile, further processed imports increased by 0.6 Mkg (+11.9%) over last year.

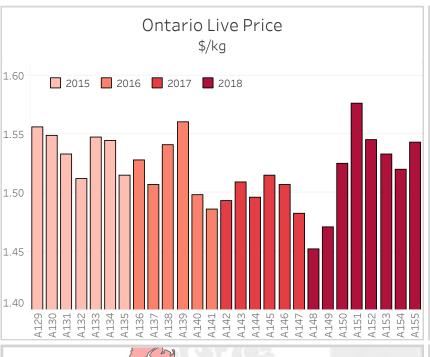

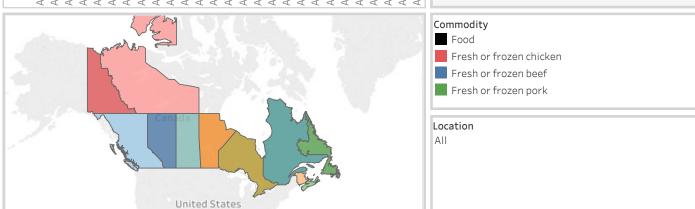

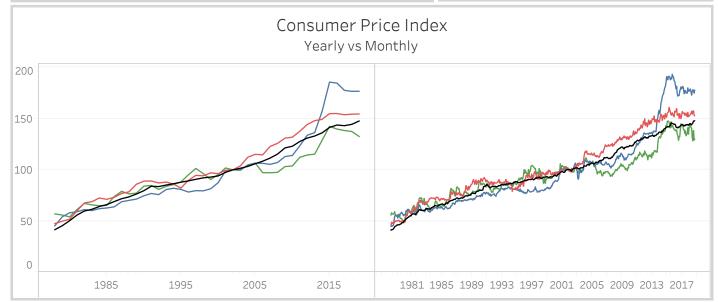
Section 2 - Chicken Prices

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The consumer price index (CPI) for chicken as of March 2019 was 152.8, increasing 0.9 points, or 0.6% over last year. The March 2019 CPI for beef was 178.0, up 3.1 points, or 1.8% from last year. Conversely, the CPI for pork was 130.1, down 5.6 points, or 4.2%. The March 2019 CPI for food at 148.0 was up 2.9% from last year.

The average market composite for March 2019 was \$3.54/kg, down \$0.15 from last year. Every complex was down over last year, however the most drastic drop was in the breast complex, which at a price of \$5.54/kg, was down \$0.33 from last year. The wing and leg complex had the second and third largest drop, falling \$0.24 and \$0.22 over last year, respectively. Lastly, the whole bird complex experienced a mild drop of \$0.05 from last year.

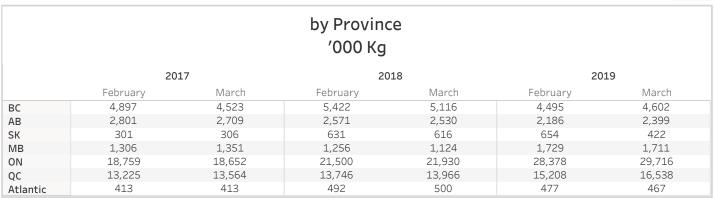

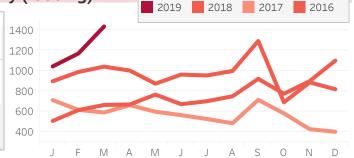
Total Chicken Storage Stocks ('000 Kg)



March 2019 storage stock levels were 55.9 Mkg, up 10.1 Mkg (+22.0%) from March 2018. Increases have been experienced in every stock category, although the largest increase was in the cut-up category, which increased by 4.7 Mkg (+22.2%). The further processed category also increased by a notable 4.3 Mkg (20.1%). Meanwhile, the whole category increased by 0.7 Mkg (+116.4%), while the miscellaneous category increased by 0.3 Mkg (+11.8%).

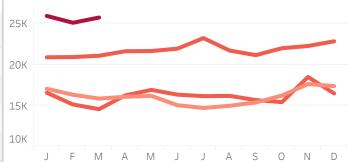

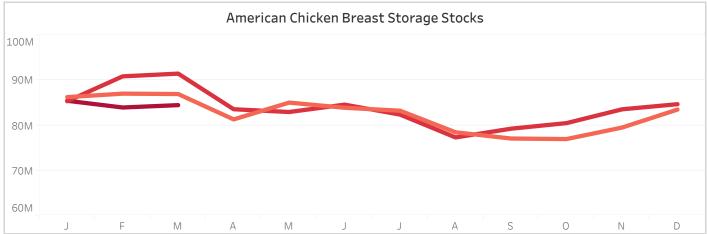
USDA - Wholesale prices

Weighted Average - Cents per pound

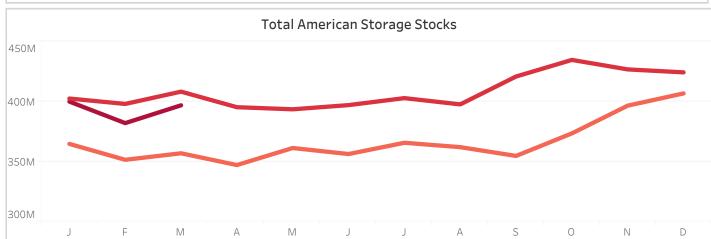


US wholesale prices for March 2019 came in with mixed results. On one side, wing prices averaged \$1.77/lb, showing an increase of \$0.21 (+13.2%) over last year. Additionally, boneless thighs came in at an average price of \$1.17/lb, up \$0.05 (+4.3%). On the flipside, boneless breast prices averaged \$1.21/lb, down \$0.06 (-4.5%) from last year. Furthermore, drumstick prices at \$0.30/lb, saw a significant drop of \$0.08 (-21.6%) from last year.
