A great diversity of age!


More women farmers are taking agriculture-related studies than ever before! Today, 1 in 5 women farmers attend post-secondary to build on their knowledge of the agriculture industry.





Since 2019, 69% of applicants to the Chicken Farmers of Canada Young Farmers Program have been female, and that number continues to grow.

At the national office of Chicken Farmers of Canada, over 74% of the staff is female, representing the sector in animal care, food safety, trade, government relations, communications, and finance.
